Next, Lenovo tests all equipment and chooses the appropriate disposal method for each device—determining whether assets should be refurbished and resold (either wholly or as parts) or recycled.

Once this process is complete, Lenovo also provides documentation and certificates associated with proper data destruction and environmental processing where appropriate, providing tangible proof of responsible asset retirement and recycling.
